- Identify the issues to be addressed and any gaps to be filled.
- Recommend an action plan on the way forward with both short-term and long-term measures for consideration by the Tourism Strategy Group.

Approach to Work

- Devise a matrix for assessing heritage and cultural items.
- Draw up a broad stock list of heritage and cultural items in Hong Kong.
- Undertake an assessment exercise as a trial attempt.
- Identify issues that need to be addressed.
- Draw up measures to address the identified issues.

Identified Issues

- Preservation, maintenance and re-use of heritage assets
- Ownership and management
- Sustainability issues
- The physical accessibility of products and the relevant support provided
- Public awareness and interest

Recommendation I: Priority Measure

As a matter of urgency, it is necessary to provide interim protection to Hong Kong's heritage assets, especially the historical buildings, while Government is continuing its review of the policy on heritage preservation.

Recommendation II: Short-Term Deliverables

- Appoint a broadly based expert panel and develop a standing assessment mechanism based on the matrix and the stock list of heritage and cultural items.
- Manage the heritage and cultural facilities in a flexible and innovative manner, and involve the participation of community groups.

Recommendation III: Long-Term Measures

- Make government historical buildings available for tourism.
- Enhance existing heritage and cultural items and provide specific training to tour guides.
- At the planning level, consider tourism use as a central factor.
- Embrace sustainable development.
- Promote Western heritage alongside Chinese heritage.
- Encourage the support of the private sector and community bodies.

Recommendation IV: Implementation and Consultation

- Set up a coordinating committee comprising a wide range of government and non-government parties both within and outside the tourism industry.
- Consult relevant parties, including government parties, statutory/advisory bodies, and trade/private sector parties.
