

Preview of "A Symphony of Lights"

A preview of "A Symphony of Lights" produced by the Tourism Commission will be held on December 20 (Saturday) at 8 pm.

“A Symphony of Lights” is a choreographed light and sound show combining special interactive light and musical effects to tell the story of Hong Kong through showcasing the 18 key buildings along the waterfront of the Victoria Harbour.

This is a brand new tourism project and will be a permanent enhancement to our harbour night scene. The Show will be the first of its kind in the world and the Tourism Commission is confident that it will attract tourists to Hong Kong.

The Show will be formally launched on January 17, 2004 to celebrate the Chinese New Year.

A preview will be held this Saturday evening for the tourism trade, a delegation led by the China National Tourism Authority and parties involved in the development of the Show. The preview will also feature rooftop pyrotechnic displays. It also serves as a full dressed rehearsal to ensure the smooth running of the Show. There will be further testing of the show over the next few weeks prior to the formal launch.

The 18 participating buildings are Bank of China Tower, Central Plaza, Cheung Kong Center, Harcourt House, Hong Kong City Hall, Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre, HSBC Main Building, Jardine House, MassMutual Tower, One Exchange Square and Two Exchange Square, One International Finance Centre and Two International Finance Centre, Queensway Government Offices, Sun Hung Kai Centre, The Center, The Chinese People's Liberation Army Forces Hong Kong Building and The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts.
