

On-the-spot broadcast for "A Symphony of Lights" to continue

In response to feedback from the public and the tourism trade, the Tourism Commission announced today (February 17) that the on-the-spot broadcast of the music and narrative of the choreographed light and sound show "A Symphony of Lights" at the Hong Kong Cultural Centre Piazza will continue after February 18.

A spokesman for Tourism Commission said, "Since its launch on January 17, the Show has been very well received by the tourism trade, visitors and the local community. Spectators particularly enjoy the on-the-spot broadcast at the Cultural Centre Piazza, saying that this allowed them to appreciate the Show in all its aspects. We have therefore decided to continue with this arrangement."

In addition to the on-the-spot broadcast, spectators can listen to the music and narrative by tuning to FM 103.4 MHz (English), FM 106.8 MHz (Cantonese) or FM 107.9 MHz (Putonghua). They can also listen to the

same soundtrack via their mobile phones by dialling 35-665-665 (English) or 35-665-668 (Putonghua). Usual service charges will apply.

The rooftop pyrotechnic displays that complement the show will cease on February 19 (Thursday) as scheduled. "The Tourism Commission will organise rooftop pyrotechnic displays again in future for special occasions," the spokesman added.
