

Rooftop pyrotechnic displays to enhance "A Symphony of Lights"

“A Symphony of Lights” will be enhanced with rooftop pyrotechnics during the coming “Golden Week” from October 2 to 7.

The number of buildings staging rooftop pyrotechnics will be increased from 10 to 12. The new buildings are Jardine House and Hopewell Centre. Jardine House is already one of the 18 existing buildings participating in “A Symphony of Lights”. The Hopewell Centre will fully join this large scale light and sound show in 2005.

The arrangement for broadcasting the narration of "A Symphony of Lights" along the Avenue of Stars from Oct 2 to 7 is as follows:

October 2 (Sat) Putonghua

October 3 (Sun) Cantonese

October 4 (Mon) English

October 5 (Tue) Putonghua

October 6 (Wed) English

October 7 (Thu) Putonghua

Spectators may also listen to the soundtrack via the radio by tuning in to FM 103.4 MHz (English), FM 106.8 MHz (Cantonese) or FM 107.9 MHz (Putonghua); or via their mobile phones by dialing 35-665-665 (English) or 35-665-668 (Putonghua).

On 1 October 2004, the National Day Fireworks Display and “A Symphony of Lights” will be staged at Victoria Harbour simultaneously. Special music for the fireworks display will be broadcast along the Tsim Sha Tsui waterfront and the Golden Bauhinia Square.
