

Government announces appointment to Hong Kong Tourism Board

The Government today (July 31) announced the appointment of Mrs Carrie Yu to the Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB). Her term will run from August 1, 2015, to July 31, 2017.

"We welcome Mrs Yu to join the Board. With her expertise and experience, we are confident that Mrs Yu will help the HKTB in enhancing Hong Kong's position as a premier tourist destination," a spokesman for the Commerce and Economic Development Bureau said.

Appointments to the HKTB are made by the Financial Secretary under section 9 of the Hong Kong Tourism Board Ordinance, under authority delegated by the Chief Executive.
