The Show has charmed millions of visitors and residents since it was launched last year. The show has also provided great business opportunities for the tourism related sectors such as restaurants, hotels, harbour cruise and tour operators.

"A Symphony of Lights" truly demonstrates the remarkable synergy of public-private partnership. This unprecedented joint venture is entirely voluntary and is put together by our Hong Kong spirit, which has long been the pride of our vibrant city.
